Chocolate can be dropped off at clearly marked donation sites; the Trust in The Hub at St Margaret's Church, and Bishopdale New World.





Te Pou Whakawhirinaki o Aotearoa

Did you know that Citizens Advice Bureau is staffed by little old ladies? You didn't. That's because it's not true.

CAB Christchurch (<u>https://www.facebook.com/</u> <u>CABchristchurcharea/</u>) has 108 volunteers, tall and short, young and ageless, mono and multilingual in English, Te Reo, Mandarin, Cantonese, Elvish, Hindu and more. (One of these may be made up).

In the past year, at five locations across the city and Rolleston, volunteers helped 801 people face-to-face, took 5521 phone calls, and answered 1131 emails and 192 online chats. On top of that, 4442 people attended CAB clinics, helping out with immigration, law, technical advice. CAB also provided 1742 people with quick answers, handy forms, foodbank referrals, contact details for language support and other useful services. All for free!

No question is too big or too small.

Last month, the top three categories were rental housing (go figure!), work conditions and relationships, followed by consumer, legal, courts and immigration issues.

CAB is always looking for new volunteers.

It matters not if you know little about rental housing, work conditions, etc. A dedicated team provides training and mentoring. If the idea of asking questions and expanding your own knowledge along with each person seeking advice appeals to you, then CAB might be right for you.

If you like the idea of learning stuff you'd always wanted to know or didn't know you wanted to know,

24/7 Defribulator

24/7 Defibrillator (AED) installed at Cotswold Mātāhae School in Bishopdale.

This has been a long term project for the school as we wanted to have this vital piece of



lifesaving equipment available for our staff and students as well as our wider community, outside of school and business hours.

We were lucky enough to be chosen by Hato Hone St Johns ; Embracing Hearts and Heart Kids NZ to have the AED installed due to Cotswold Mātāhae School having Ayden, a very special heart child enrolled at our school.

We are extremely grateful to Hato Hone St Johns ; Embracing Hearts (a charity that donates automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to schools); and Heart Kids NZ (who support families impacted by childhood heart conditions) who together with the support of the Cotswold Mātāhae School Board of Trustees helped to fund the unit, and the installation of the AED. It is located at the entrance to the Cotswold Mātāhae School Office at 50 Cotswold Avenue in Bishopdale.

When someone goes into cardiac arrest, every second is crucial, and having this piece of lifesaving equipment here at school means it is available for our staff and students, but will also provide reassurance to know it is accessible to our wider community outside of school hours.

According to Heart Kids NZ, 12 Kiwi children are diagnosed with a heart condition each week. Embracing Hearts is a charity who aims to get an AED installed at every school in New Zealand with a heart kid.

Our new AED has been added to the AED locations app, making it easy for those in our community to find the device closest to them in an emergency. <u>https://aedlocations.co.nz/</u>

There are not a lot of AEDS accessible 24/7 so we encourage the community to download this App should they need to locate one in an emergency.

We held an official Launch of our AED at school on Monday 26 June 2023 (see photo to the left)


